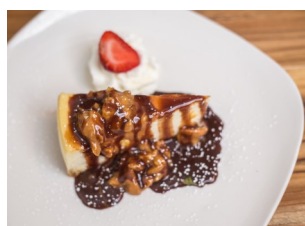

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An afternoon of adventure

Bellevue, 204 Ben Hill Street, LaGrange, 706-884-1832

Built circa 1853, this impressive antebellum mansion in Greek-Revival style was the home of U.S. Senator Benjamin Harvey Hill. Located near downtown LaGrange, it has been restored and is open to the public for tours.

Biblical History Center, 130 Gordon Commercial Drive, LaGrange, 706-885-0363

Ancient times come alive at this interactive museum of life in biblical lands, through full-scale archaeological reconstructions of real discoveries.

Hills and Dales Estate, 1916 Hills & Dales Drive, LaGrange, 706-882-3242

This historic estate was the home of textile magnate Fuller E. Callaway Sr. and his family. The estate features the historic Ferrell Gardens created by Sarah Coleman Ferrell in the early 19th century.

LaGrange Art Museum, 112 Lafayette Square, LaGrange, 706-882-3267

The museum occupies a renovated three-story 1892 Victorian building. Changing exhibits feature a wide range of artists. Art classes are also available.

Legacy Museum on Main, 136 Main Street, LaGrange, 706-884-1828

Legacy Museum on Main tells the story of the people of West Georgia. Using temporary and permanent exhibits of photographs, artifacts, and documents, the museum brings to life the history and traditions of a population rich in diversity.

Stonewall Jackson Cemetery & Horace King Gravesite, Miller Street, LaGrange

Some 300 soldiers from the Confederate Army of Tennessee are buried here. Just outside the cemetery are the graves of former slave and master bridge builder Horace King and his son.

Shopping in downtown LaGrange provides an assortment of quaint boutiques, elegant antique shops and unique selections.
